



#### Intellectualis — Contributor Guidelines

## I. Aim and Scope

Intellectualis is an initiative of the Intellectual Property Rights Committee (IPRC) under the banner of School of Law, CHRIST (Deemed to be University). It is IPRC's flagship bi-monthly e-newsletter, intended to serve as a forum to stimulate scholarly discussion on intellectual property law. This year (2023 - 2024), collaborations have been planned with several reputed organisations and firms, thereby providing immense professional recognition to authors' work published in *Intellectualis*.

The IPRC indulges in activities to provide students an opportunity to create an impact through their contribution. Through *Intellectualis*, the Committee seeks to bridge industry practice and academia. Any individual interested in IP law, at any stage of their careers, may engage in high-quality scholarly research through this e-newsletter. Submissions from undergraduate students are encouraged.

#### **II. Guidelines for Submissions**

#### 1. Articles

Articles must not exceed 2000 words. Do ensure that you begin with outlining the legal context and practical relevance of the subject matter.

## 2. Case Analyses

Case analyses must be of recent cases that have, in your opinion, significantly contributed to IP jurisprudence. Analyses must be structured in the following format in 500-800 words.

- Case name
- Citation
- Court

- Bench
- Facts
- · Parties' arguments
- Laws involved
- Contemporary significance

## 3. Other works

- Comic strips
- Artwork

Please note that submissions under this section will be subject to approval from the University Publication Office.

#### III. Format and References

- Please ensure that the font is in Times New Roman, size 12 with 1.5 line spacing.
- Intellectualis follows the Bluebook 20th Edition style, which must be referenced under the Title "References" at the end of the article. Footnotes and endnotes are not permitted.

## IV. Mode of Submission

- Contributions other than comic strips and artwork may be shared as a Google document via an email to <a href="mailto:ipr@law.christuniversity.in">ipr@law.christuniversity.in</a>.
- The email must contain the authors' names, contact details, and details of their university or any other affiliation. Receipt of the same will be confirmed within 2-3 working days.
- Please note that any edits to contributions other than comic strips and artwork will be made through "suggestions" on Google Docs.
- Authors are expected to make changes prior to acceptance or publication, as intimated by the Committee.

## V. Key Considerations for Authors

• The sole aim of *Intellectualis* is to serve as an platform to facilitate the exchange of knowledge. Do use formal tone and language.

• Authors will be asked to sign a declaration upon submission to ensure that adherence to standards of academic integrity.

# VI. Copyright

- All contributions will be reviewed by student editors subject to the decision of the supervising faculty members and approval thereof by the University's publication office.
- Copyright to the contribution rests with CHRIST (Deemed to be University).
- It is pertinent for authors to note that if there is a subsequent publication of accepted work, the author will have to provide prior notice of the name at <a href="mailto:ipr@law.christuniversity.in">ipr@law.christuniversity.in</a>.
